

ORDINANCE 81-84

To Repeal Ordinance 80-95 Establishing a Procedure for  
Selling and Leasing Surplus Real Property by the City of Bloomington

WHEREAS, IC 36-1-11 passed by the 1981 General Assembly establishes procedures for local governments to dispose of government property; and


WHEREAS, legislation by the General Assembly on the subject of property disposal overrides any procedure established by the Common Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:



SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




