

ORDINANCE 81-99

To Amend the 1982 Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees to Add Two Positions to the Human Resources Department

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the first day of January, 1982, the following classified positions, salaries, and pay schedules for the Human Resources Department be incorporated into Section I. of Ordinance 81-75, Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees of the City of Bloomington:

Section I. Human Resources Specialist	\$11,815
Secretary II/PPT	5.28

SECTION II. The rates shown as wages and salary for the positions listed above are the maximum rates.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
