

RESOLUTION 81-16

To Approve an Application to the Federal Section 8  
Housing Program by the Bloomington Housing Authority

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Title II - Section 201 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-383), amending the Housing Act of 1937, local housing authorities may receive financial assistance through the Section 8 "Lower-Income Housing Assistance" program for the purpose of providing low-rent housing by leasing dwelling units in privately-owned structures; and


WHEREAS, such provisions may not apply to any locality unless the governing body of the locality has by resolution approved the application of such provisions to such locality; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Bloomington wishes to submit an application for Section 8 Lower-Income Housing Assistance for 115 units;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

In accordance with provisions of Title II of Section 201 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (P.L. 93-383), amending the United States Housing Act of 1937, relating to the Section 8 "Lower-Income Housing Assistance" program, the Housing Authority of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is hereby authorized to submit an application for Section 8 Lower-Income Assistance for 115 units.
