ORDINANCE 80-19

To Repeal Section 2.04.290 and Amend Subsection 2.04.380(a) of the  
Bloomington Municipal Code, Regarding Fiscal Impact Statements

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,  
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 2.04.290 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled  
"Ordinances and resolutions--Fiscal impact statement required" shall be  
repealed.

SECTION II. Subsection (a) of Section 2.04.380, entitled "Order of  
business" shall be amended to read as follows:

2.04.380 Order of business. (a) The council shall transact its busi-  
ness in the following order, but it may by majority vote amend the normal  
order of business:

- (1) Roll call;
- (2) Messages from council members;
- (3) Messages from the mayor;
- (4) Reports from city bodies;
- (5) Petitions and communications from the public;
- (6) Second readings of legislation in the following order:
  - a. Committee report on proposed legislation with synopsis;
  - b. Statement by sponsor of legislation;
  - c. Opening comments by council member;
  - d. Statement by person or group directly affected by legislation;
  - e. Comments from the public;
  - f. Debate and vote by council members;
- (7) First reading of ordinances;
- (8) Approval of minutes;
- (9) Adjournment.

SECTION III. Ordinances 77-23 and 78-71 are hereby repealed in their  
entirety.
