

ORDINANCE 80-24

To Amend the 1980 Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees,
To Create the Position of City Engineer/Administrator

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the seventh day of March, 1980, pursuant to IC 18-2-1-10, the following classified position, salary and pay schedule for the Engineering Department be deleted from Sections I and II of Ordinance 79-55, Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees of the City of Bloomington:

SECTION II. That from and after the seventh day of March, 1980, pursuant to IC 18-2-1-10, the following classified position, salary, and pay schedule for the Engineering Department be incorporated into Sections I and II of Ordinance 79-55, Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees of the City of Bloomington:

SECTION III. The rate shown as wages and salary for the positions listed above is the maximum rate.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
