## To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

- WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and
- WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-5-80, and recommended that the petitioner, Realco, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RH - General Density Residential, to BG - General Business, for property located on the east side of the 100 block of North Curry Pike, more particularly described as:

Part of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 9 north, range 2 west, to-wit: Beginning at a point that is 47 rods and 73.50 feet north of the southwest corner of said southeast quarter, said point being in the centerline of Curry Pike, thence east for a distance of 148.50 feet, thence north for a distance of 250.89 feet, thence west for a distance of 148.5 feet to the centerline of Curry Pike, thence south over and along said centerline of Curry Pike for a distance of 250.89 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 0.85 acre, more or less.

A part of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 9 north, range 2 west, more particularly described as: Beginning at a point that is 47 rods and 73.50 feet north and 148.50 feet east of the southwest corner of said southeast quarter; thence east for a distance of 106.50 feet, thence north for a distance of 250.89 feet, thence west for a distance of 106.50 feet, thence south for a distance of 250.89 feet to the place of beginning. Containing .61 acre, more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
