

ORDINANCE 80-45

To Amend the 1980 Salary Ordinance for Utilities Employees to Reallocate the Position of Assistant Distribution Superintendent in the City of Bloomington's Position Classification Plan.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. From and after the first day of May, 1980, pursuant to IC 8-1-2-100, the following classified position, salary, and pay schedule for Assistant Distribution Superintendent be deleted from Section II of Ordinance 79-65, Salary Ordinance for Utility Employees of the City of Bloomington:

Pay Grade	Classification	Hourly Job Rate	Salaried Job Rate
16	Assistant Distribution Superintendent	\$5.05	\$10,492

SECTION II. That from and after the first day of May, 1980, pursuant to IC 8-1-2-100, the following classified position, salary, and pay schedule for Assistant Distribution Superintendent be incorporated into Section II of Ordinance 79-65, Salary Ordinance for Utility Employees of the City of Bloomington:



SECTION III. The rates shown as wages and salaries for the positions listed previously are maximum rates.


SECTION IV. This ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

This ordinance would reallocate the position of Assistant Distribution Superintendent in the Transmission and Distribution Division of the Utilities Department from a Grade 16 in the Salary Ordinance (and Classification Plan) to Grade 19. This would correct an error in allocation and would place the position in proper sequence with regard to progressive levels of supervisory responsibility. The ordinance would be retroactive to May 1, 1980.
