

ORDINANCE 80-46

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.




SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.



SYNOPSIS

This transfer makes possible fuller computerization of the Fleet Maintenance and Animal Control departments by providing them with access to the computer from their offices.
