ORDINANCE 80-53

To Amend Section 15.68.130, Entitled "Hourly Charge--Restrictions on Certain Lots", and Section 15.68.140, Entitled "Annual Parking Rates--Permits", of the Bloomington Municipal Code

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Subsection (b) of Section 15.68.130 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Hourly charge--Restrictions on certain lots", be amended to read as follows:

(b) The charge for the use of the Municipal Parking Lot No. 3 shall be five cents per thirty-minute period or part thereof and ten cents per sixty minutes for the use of each space, between the hours of nine a.m. and nine p.m. The charge for the use of each space shall be collected by parking meters and any person parking a motor vehicle in a metered space shall deposit coins of the United States in payment. No vehicle shall park in Municipal Lot No. 3 for more than four hours when parking meters are in operation during any calendar day, <u>except that</u> vehicles with current parking permits issued in accordance with section 15.68.140 shall be exempt from the four-hour restriction.

SECTION II. Section 15.68.140 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Annual parking rates--Permits", shall be amended to read as follows:

<u>15.68.140</u> Annual parking rates--Permits. (a) Parking privileges shall be made available to all motorists at their election to park in any of the city parking lots on a rental basis. The charge for such privilege shall be one hundred twelve dollars and fifty cents annually, payable in advance, if such motorist is a resident of the city, and such charge shall be two hundred twenty-five dollars if such motorist is not a resident of the city.

(b) The city shall furnish for each motor vehicle upon the application for such parking privilege and upon the payment as hereinabove set out a permit showing the payment therefor. All motor vehicles which display such a permit on the lower right-hand corner of the windshield may park in any available stall in any of the city municipal parking lots. All motor vehicles so parked are subject to all the provisions of all ordinances concerning the city parking lots, except that vehicles with current parking permits shall be exempt from the restrictions on the number of hours per day that vehicles may park in the city parking lots.

(c) It shall be the duty of the city controller to issue the permit and collect and account for the rents received therefrom and deposit such moneys to the credit of the city in a special fund provided by law for parking meter receipts.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its pasage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

Under the current Municipal Code, persons with parking permits issued by the city may park for an unlimited period of time in any municipal lot except the Fourth and Washington Streets lot, which has a four-hour parking restriction. This ordinance, sponsored by Councilmember Towell, would remove this restriction and allow vehicles with permits to park on an unlimited basis in all municipal lots.
