

ORDINANCE 80-62

To Amend Various Sections of Chapter 2.90 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, Entitled "Human Resources Department," To Remove References to the Human Rights Commission and Office of Equal Employment Opportunity

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Subsection (i) of Section 2.90.020 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Human resources department--Scope and duties" shall be deleted and the remaining section shall be redesignated accordingly.

SECTION II. Subsection (b) of Section 2.90.060, entitled "Other city human resources activities", shall be amended to read:

- (b) The director of human resources shall exercise direct supervision over all staff working for the program of the commission on the status of women.

SECTION III. Subsection (c) of Section 2.90.060, entitled "Other city human resources activities", shall be deleted and the remaining section shall be redesignated accordingly.

SECTION IV. Section 2.90.080, entitled "Office of equal employment opportunity", shall be deleted.


SECTION V. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


