

ORDINANCE 80-67

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, Z0/MP-37-80, and recommended that the petitioner, B.F. GOODRICH COMPANY, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RS to MG for property located at along East side of Woodlawn, North of Hillside Drive. more particularly described as:

Lots 81,82,83,84,85,86,87,88,89,90,91,93,94,95,96,97,98, 153,154, and 155 of Edgemont Park Addition to the City of Bloomington.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

The proposed ordinance will result in a change of zone from RS to MG for a portion of the old Tarzian plant site located east of South Woodlawn, north of Hillside. The site is within the corporate limits of the City and no improvements for the site in question are currently proposed. No costs to the City are anticipated nor are substantially increased revenues, as a result of increased property tax revenues, expected. Favorable economic ramifications to the City will result from the utilization of the almost vacant Tarzian factory by Goodrich and the new employment opportunities created.
