ORDINANCE 80-86

To Amend the Bloomington Municipal Code to Reduce the Time Period for Application of Late Payment Charges for Water and Wastewater Bills

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 9.08.070 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Water--Late payment charge", shall be amended to read as follows:

9.08.070 Late payment charge. Except as otherwise provided, all bills shall be due and payable monthly and bills unpaid more than twenty days following the date of mailing shall be considered delinquent. Delinquent bills shall include a late payment charge of three percent of the unpaid bill. This charge shall be paid only once and shall be based on the unpaid overdue balance.

SECTION II. Section 10.08.080 of the Municipal Code, currently incorporated in Section I of Ordinance 80-26 and entitled "Wastewater--Billing", shall be amended to read as follows:

10.08.080 Billing. Rates and charges shall be billed monthly and shall be due and payable twenty days from the mailing of the bill.

SECTION III. Section 10.08.090 of the Municipal Code, currently incorporated in Section I of Ordinance 80-26 and entitled "Wastewater--Delinquencies--Late payment charge", shall be amended to read as follows:

10.08.090 Delinquencies--Late payment charge. In the event a net bill is not paid within twenty days from the mailing of the bill, it shall become a delinquent bill and a late payment charge may be added to the bill in the amount of three percent of the unpaid balance.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
