

ORDINANCE 80-96

To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-54-80, and recommended that the petitioner, Plan Commission, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from RS-Single Family Residential to SM-Special Medical for property located at First and Walker Streets (block size area) more particularly described as:

Part of Seminary Lots 51, 59, & 60 In the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana; more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 15' south of the northwest corner of Seminary Lot #59. Thence proceeding east for 585' more or less and to the present SM zoning line, thence proceeding north for 546' to a point 230' north and 50' east of the southwest corner of Seminary Lot #51; East thence proceeding west for 435' to a point 120.5' East and 330' South of the Northwest corner of Seminary Lot #60; Thence proceeding South for 107'; Thence proceeding West for 120.5' to the West line of Seminary Lot #60; Thence proceeding South along the west lines of Seminary lots #60 & 59 for 437' and to the place of beginning containing 7.03 acres more or less.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
