ORDINANCE 80-99

To Amend Section 2.78.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code and Raise the Salaries of Utilities Service Board Members

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 2.78.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Utilities Service Board - Salary" shall be amended to read as follows:

2.78.040 Salary. The members of the Board shall be paid a salary, to be budgeted from utilities funds, of two thousand <u>two hundred</u> <u>ninety dollars</u> per year, <u>and the chairperson of the board shall be paid</u> <u>a salary of two thousand eight hundred dollars</u>. The members of the Board shall be reimbursed for expenses properly incurred in connection with their duties pursuant to this chapter. No member of the Board who is an elected or salaried official of the City otherwise, shall receive the above mentioned salary.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after January 1, 1981.
