## ORDINANCE 80-100

## To Amend the Bloomington Zoning Maps, Dated June 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978 which are now incorporated in Title 20 of the Bloomington Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-67-80, and recommended that the petitioner, Roger & Carol Curry, be granted an amendment to the Bloomington zoning maps and request that the Common Council consider their petition for rezoning of certain property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Through the authority of IC 18-7-4 that the zoning be changed from Special Institutional (SI) to General Business (BG) for property located at 200-203 E. Third Street more particularly described as:

A part of the South Fractional Lot Number Twenty (20) in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of said South Fractional Lot Number Twenty (20), thence running South Seventy-five (75) feet, more or less, to the township line, thence East Forty-five (45) feet, thence North Twenty-eight (28) feet, thence West Five (5) feet, thence North Forty-seven (47) feet to the South line of East Third Street, thence West on the South line of East Third Street to the place of beginning.

Also, that part of South Washington Street in the city of Bloomington, Indiana, which lies West of South Fractional Lot Number Twenty (20), in the city of Bloomington, Indiana, and the East line of the permanent sidewalk now constructed on the East side of South Washington Street, upon which said South Fractional Lot Number Twenty (20) abutts, being about Twenty-one (21) feet, more or less.

Beginning at the Northwest corner of South Fractional Lot Number Twenty (20) in the City of Bloomington, Indiana, running thence East Sixty-one (61) feet; thence North One and Thirty-one (1,31) hundredths feet; thence West Sixty-one (61) feet; thence South One and Thirty-one Hundredths (1,31) feet and to the place of beginning.

Also,
A part of the West Half of South Fractional Lot No. 20 in the
City of Bloomington, Indiana described as follows: Commencing
on the North line of said lot 20 feet East of the Northwest corner
thereof, running thence East 6 feet; thence South to a point on the
South line thereof 46 feet East of the Southwest corner thereof;
thence West 1 foot on the said South line thereof, thence North 28
feet; thence West 5 feet, thence North 47 feet, more or less, and to
the North line of said lot and to the place of beginning.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Nayor.

This ordinance would rezone the property at 200-203 E. Third From SI to BG based on this criterion.
