

RESOLUTION 80-11

To Approve the Order of the Plan Commission Concerning the Approval and Support of the Central Business District Amended Redevelopment Plan

The Common Council approves the Order issued by the Plan Commission on April 7, 1980 concerning amendment of the Central Business District Amended Redevelopment Plan.



SYNOPSIS

The Central Business District Development Plan, approved in 1972 by the Common Council and the Redevelopment and Plan Commissions, does not specifically provide for the construction of a parking garage, nor for its location on the Northwest corner off the square. A resolution has been passed by the Redevelopment and Plan Commissions to amend the plan to provide for such a garage. State law requires that the Common Council pass a resolution approving their amendment.
