SYNOPSIS

Appropriation Ordinance 80-3

This ordinance contains two unrelated appropriation requests.

The first request under Board of Works constitutes funding for the repairs to the Police Station necessitated by serious termite Mare than damage recently reported there. This amount will not be sufficient to pay the entire bill for those repairs. However, because Revenue Sharing appropriations must be advertised weeks before they come to the Council, this amount, a very early estimate; was used in the legal ad just so the City could get the appropriation under way.

The second appropriation represents the remaining amount due the Greater Bloomington Chamber of Commerce for support of their economic development coordinator position. Last year's Council resolved to support this position with \$4,000 in 1979 and \$8,000 in 1980.
