SYNOPSIS

Each year the Common Council is required to approve the budget for the Utility Department. This appropriation ordinance would budget \$3,457,018 for the water utility and \$3,644,300 for the wastewater utility. These budgets were approved by the Utilities Service Board for the year 1981.
