

ORDINANCE 79-19

To Amend the Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers and Employees
To Fix the Salary of General Superintendent and Administrative
Assistant in the Department of Public Works and to Delete
Rosehill Cemetery Superintendent, Rosehill Bookkeeper,
and the Sanitation Superintendent

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the 16th day of April, 1979, the salary and
pay schedule of the following appointed officers and employees of the City of Bloom-
ington, Monroe County, Indiana, be fixed as follows:

SALARY SCHEDULE AS PRESENTED BY
MAYOR FRANCIS X. McCLOSKEY

I, the undersigned, Francis X. McCloskey, Mayor of the City of Bloomington,
Indiana, as required by Indiana Code 18-1-11-1 do hereby fix the salary and create
the following City of Bloomington employee position beginning April 16, 1979 and
continuing thereafter until duly changed and request that such salary rate be
approved by the Common Council of said City:

that such positions be deleted by the Common Council of said City:

position beginning April 16, 1979 and continuing thereafter until duly changed and
request that such salary rate be approved by the Common Council of said City:

SYNOPSIS

The Board of Public Works has adopted a resolution to create the position of "General Superintendent" to supervise City refuse collection, Rosehill Cemetery, and other special projects such as the CETA clean-up project which will begin April 1. The elimination of Sanitation Superintendent, Cemetery Superintendent, and Rosehill Bookkeeper will achieve greater departmental efficiency, increased coordination of services, and provide an annual net savings of \$7,000 in 1979. The Administrative Assistant in the Department of Public Works will assume the responsibilities of the Rosehill Bookkeeper, hence the increase in salary.
