ORDINANCE 79-23

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BLOOMINGTON ZONING MAPS, DATED JUNE 7, 1978

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, passed a Zoning Ordinance amendment and adopted new incorporated zoning maps on June 7, 1978, and

WHEREAS, said Zoning Ordinance and maps are now incorporated in the Bloomington Municipal Code as Title 20 of said Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Plan Commission has considered this case, ZO-11-79 and recommended said Bloomington zoning maps be amended by the rezoning of certain property, and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, RICHARD J. BARTLETT , requests that the Common Council of the City of Bloomington consider this petition for the rezoning of said property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, that the authority of Chapter 174 of the 1947 Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, as amended, that the zoning on property located at the Southwest corner of Thornton Drive and Park St. be changed from RH-High Density Residential Districts to ML-Light Manufacturing and Industrial District.

SECTION 1. That the Bloomington Zoning Map of June 7, 1978 be amended to rezone the following described land as follows, to-wit:

Lot Number 30 in Barclay Gardens, being a sub-division of the west half of the northeast quarter and part of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter and part of the east half of the northeast quarter and part of the north half of the northwest quarter of Section 9, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, with the exception of 60 feet of even width off of the south end of said lot.

Also Lot Number 31 in Barclay Gardens, being a subdivison of Section 9, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, except 79 feet off of the south end of said lot, said exception being all that part of said lot lying south of the north line of the Ditch or Branch which runs through said lot.

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 79-23

To Amend the Zoning Maps of June 7, 1978

This ordinance, if approved, will change the zoning from RH-High Density Residential to ML-Light Manufacturing and Industrial on an approximately 0.4 acre parcel located at the southwest corner of Thornton and Park. The petitioner is Richard J. Bartlett and the proposed use is as a woodworking mill.
