

ORDINANCE NO. 79-30

Salary Ordinance for Appointed Officers
and Employees, To fix the salary of
Sanitation Superintendent.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

SECTION I. That from and after the 19 day of April, 1979, the
salary and pay schedule of the following appointed employee of the City
of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, be fixed as follows:

SALARY SCHEDULE AS PRESENTED BY
THE BLOOMINGTON COMMON COUNCIL

I, the undersigned, Francis X. McCloskey, Mayor of the City of
Bloomington, Indiana, as required by Indiana Code 18-1-11-1 do hereby
fix the salary for the following City of Bloomington employee position
beginning April 19, 1979, and continuing thereafter until September
30, 1979, and request that such salary rate be approved by the Common
Council of said City, to-wit:

and after its passage by the Common Council.


