

ORDINANCE 79-32

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance would transfer funds in the Board of Works to pay for a portion of the cost of building repairs to the roof of Fire Station #4 on Third Street and for rock removal for an underground storage tank that was installed at the Service Center. The funds are being transferred from the insurance line item because the city's general liability and workers compensation insurance bill was lower than anticipated.
