ORDINANCE 79-36

To Amend Section 15.76.010 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, Entitled "Stop Intersections"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOM-INGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.76.010(3) of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled "Three-way stop intersections", shall be amended to add the following:

Henderson Street and Maxwell Lane

SECTION II. Section 15.76.010(1), entitled "Stop intersections generally", shall be amended to delete the following:

Henderson Street at Maxwell Lane

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

The Council voted on March 8, 1979 to remove the stop signs on Henderson at Maxwell on the recommendation of the Traffic Commission, Police Department and City Engineer. Several of the residents of the area have since submitted a petition to the Council requesting that the signs be put back because of the problems of children crossing the street and of drivers turning off of Maxwell Lane onto Henderson. This ordinance, sponsored by Councilmember Richardson, would again make Henderson and Maxwell a three-way stop intersection.
