

ORDINANCE 79-62

To Amend Section 2.64.010 of the Bloomington Municipal Code and Set Mileage Rate Paid to City Employees

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 2.64.010 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

2.64.010 Mileage Allowance. In all instances where city employees use their own vehicles in city affairs and work, other than traveling from their home to their place of work and from their place of work to their home, such employee shall be entitled to an allowance of twenty cents per mile for each mile actually traveled.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on January 1, 1980.
