RESOLUTION NO. 79-24

A Resolution by the City of Bloomington
Committing Matching Funds for the
Rehabilitation of Crestmont Park Complex.

WHEREAS, the City of Bloomington Parks and Recreation Department plans to submit a grant application for approximately \$100,000 on August 30, 1979 to the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service (HCRS), a division of the Department of the Interior (under the Urban Parks and Recreation Recovery Program); and

WHEREAS, projects eligible for the grant program must be directed at rehabilitation of older neighborhood parks; and

WHEREAS, the staff of the Parks and Recreation Department, the Planning Department, the Mayor's Office and the city grants-person have determined that Crestmont Park Complex is the one park most eligible for rehabilitation funds under the grant; and


WHEREAS, the program is 70% federally funded and requires 30% local funding and the HCRS requires a resolution by the Common Council committing the City to provide the 30% matching funds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 1. The City of Bloomington does hereby commit and agree to approve matching funds in an amount not to exceed thirty percent (30%) of the total grant and for the rehabilitation of Crestmont Park Complex if the grant for said project is approved by the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service.

Section 2. The amount of matching funds hereby authorized is not to exceed \$30,000.00.
