

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 79-8

AN ORDINANCE SPECIALLY APPROPRIATING FROM THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST FUND AND THE LOCAL ROAD AND STREET SPECIAL DISTRIBUTION FUND EXPENDITURES NOT OTHERWISE APPROPRIATED OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; now, therefore;

SECTION I. Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, of Monroe County, Indiana that for the expenses of said municipal corporation the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

SYNOPSIS

Appropriation Ordinance 79- 8

Two separate appropriations are included in this ordinance.

The appropriation in Local Road and Street Special Distribution is simply a bookkeeping matter; the City has already appropriated \$21,000 of City money toward the location study, 70% of the project will be finance by federal money which must be appropriated so that it may be dispersed. The total project cost will be \$65,400, only \$16,350 to be paid by City funds.

Harmony School is requesting \$2,000.00 in Federal Revenue Sharing to help fund their proposed summer program.
