

ORDINANCE 78-10

To Amend Chapter 10 of the Bloomington Municipal Code,
Entitled "Sanitation Company", and Establish New Wastewater Rate Structure

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 10.04.070 shall be amended to read as follows:

10.04.070 Rates - Metered water customers. General service rates shall be applicable to all metered water customers except those with other than average strengths of BOD and suspended solids. The rates shall be determined as follows:

SECTION II. Section 10.04.120 shall be amended to read as follows:

10.04.120 Rates - Non-metered water customers. The minimum rate or charge for any service where the user is not a metered water consumer shall be \$151.00 per year, payable monthly.

SECTION III. Section 10.04.150 shall be amended to read as follows:

10.04.150 Rates - October, November, and December. Charges for service to residential customers shall be based upon the average usage of such customers for the three-month period October, November and December of each year. All other customers shall be charged on the basis of 100 per cent of metered water consumption subject to customer proof of lower wastewater use.

SECTION IV. Section 10.08.145 shall be amended to read as follows:

10.08.145 Special Service Rates. Special service rates shall be applicable to all customers with strengths of BOD and suspended solids that vary from system average strengths as determined by special laboratory analysis by the Utilities Department Special Laboratory. Strength charges are to be computed on actual measured strengths and volumes. The charge shall be made on the following basis:

SECTION V. The new rates shall be in effect for the use and services rendered by the Sewage Works beginning March 1, 1978.

SECTION VI. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance.

SECTION VII. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

IC 19-2-5-20 gives the Common Council power to establish rates and charges for the use of and service rendered by the Sewage Works. This ordinance establishes a new wastewater rate structure and a new system for special service rates for customers whose wastes are monitored by the Utilities Department. The new rates will go into effect on March 1, 1978.
