SYNOPSIS

Ordinance 78-13

This budget transfer solves several problems in the Fleet Maintenance department without the City having to resort to special appropriations.

Fleet Maintenance, like all other City departments, owes more for casualty insurance than was budgeted. Because the department does not owe for workmen's compensation, Fleet Maintenance cannot be included in the appropriation out of Local Public Works Title II money; because the amount is small, it can be transferred in order to make the payment.

During negotiations with the Union, the City agreed to pay a tool allowance to men working in Fleet Maintenace. A transfer must be effected into the appropriate category so that those payments can be made.

Finally, the department must buy some large equipment which can only be purchased out of #72.
