ORDINANCE NO. 78-15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTIONS 15.36.200 ENTITLED, "ONE WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS, 15.64.080 ENTITLED, "PARALLEL PARKING" AND 15.64.370 ENTITLED "RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That Section 15.36.200, of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled, "One Way Streets and Alleys", is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

The alley running west, north of the church at 417 East 16th Street shall be designated One Way West.

SECTION 2. That Section 15.64.080, of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled, "Parallel Parking-Unlimited", is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

708 North Indiana Avenue on the east side of the street shall be designated as Parallel Parking (Unlimited Time).

SECTION 3. That Section 15.64.370, of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled, "Restricted Parking Zones", is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

The 400 block of West 6th Street on the south side of the street, the first parking space east of the north-south alley shall be designated as 30 minute parking zone.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signature in accordance with the law.

SYNOPSIS

ORDINANCE NO. 78-15

An Ordinance to Amend the Bloomington Municipal Code
Regarding One Way Streets and Alleys, Parallel
Parking and Restricted Parking Zones

The City of Bloomington has power to make laws regarding certain aspects of parking and traffic control on its streets, and these are collected in the "Vehicles and Traffic" sections of the Bloomington Municipal Code. Consequently when parking, speed zone, or sign changes are found to be required by the Traffic Commission or other member of the City Administration, the Council must amend the code to incorporate the changes.

This ordinance makes changes in the following:

One-Way Streets and Alleys:

The alley running west, north of the church at 417 East 16th Street shall be designated One-Way West,

Parallel Parking

708 North Indiana Avenue on the East side of the street shall be designated as Parallel Parking (Unlimited Time)

Restricted Parking Zones:

The 400 block of West 6th Street on the south side of the street, the first parking space east of the north-south alley shall be designated as 30 minute parking zone.
