

ORDINANCE 78-26

To Amend Title 15 of the Bloomington Municipal Code by  
Amending Section 15.64.370 Entitled "Restricted Parking Zones"


BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON,  
MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 15.64.370 of the Bloomington Municipal Code entitled  
"Restricted Parking Zones" be amended by adding thereto the following:


Two spaces in the 1100 block of North College Avenue on the east  
side of the street directly south of the alley separating 1100 from 1112  
N. College and north of the unlimited parking zone at the south end of  
the block shall be designated as a fifteen-minute parking zone.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from  
and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

The City of Bloomington has power to make laws regarding certain aspects  
of parking and traffic control on its streets. When changes in the Code are  
found to be required by the Traffic Commission or other members of the City  
administration, the Council must amend the Code to incorporate the changes.

This ordinance would change the parking on the east side of the 1100  
block of North College at the south end of the block from unlimited to fif-  
teen minutes.
