

ORDINANCE NO. 78-40

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF  
ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,  
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the same  
is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of Bloomington,  
Indiana, to-wit:

Part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 10, Town-  
ship 8 North, Range 1 West in Monroe County, Indiana,  
more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of the said Quarter  
Section; thence South 00 degrees 06 minutes 30 seconds  
West along the East line of the said Quarter Section  
1974.60 feet to a point on a line witnessed by a 6  
inch square cut stone bearing North 89 degrees 11  
minutes 16 seconds West 4.54 feet and a 6 inch square  
cut stone bearing North 89 degrees 11 minutes 16  
seconds West 2605.10 feet; thence North 89 degrees 11  
minutes 16 seconds West along the said line (assumed  
to be the North line of the South half of the South-  
east Quarter of said Southeast Quarter Section as  
annexed by the City of Bloomington by Ordinance Number  
77-27) a distance of 529.55 feet to the place of be-  
ginning which is the Southwest corner of Lot 79 in  
Spicewood Addition-Section Five, the plat of which was  
recorded December 15, 1975 in Plat Book 6, page 90 in  
the Office of the Recorder of Monroe County, Indiana;  
continue thence North 89 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds  
West along the said line 879.47 feet to the Southeast  
corner of land conveyed to Bloomington Metropolitan  
Schools, Elementary School Building Corporation, by  
deed recorded in Deed Record 170, pages 299 through  
301 in the said Recorders Office; thence North 14  
degrees 43 minutes 41 seconds West along the Easterly  
line of the said School land 282.78 feet to the South-  
west corner of Spicewood Addition-Section Two, the  
plat of which was recorded March 12, 1975 in Plat  
Book 6, page 70 in the said Recorders Office; thence  
South 85 degrees 11 minutes 16 seconds East along the  
Southerly line of the said Spicewood Addition-Section  
Two 298.37 feet to the Southwest corner of Spicewood  
Addition-Section Six, the plat of which was recorded  
December 15, 1975 in Plat Book 6 page 91 in the said  
Recorders Office; thence South 66 degrees 11 minutes  
16 seconds East along the Southerly line of the said  
Spicewood Addition-Section Six 356.84 feet to the  
Southwest corner of the said Spicewood Addition-  
Section Five (the next three courses are along the  
Southerly boundaries of the said Spicewood Addition-  
Section Five); thence South 66 degrees 11 minutes  
16 seconds East 113.13 feet; thence South 89 degrees  
11 minutes 16 seconds East 224.98 feet; thence South  
00 degrees 48 minutes 44 seconds West 68.00 feet to  
the place of beginning, containing 3.492 acres, more  
or less.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove described as part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor and publication in accordance with the law.
