

ORDINANCE 78-41

To Amend Chapter 10 of the Bloomington Municipal Code,
Entitled, "Sanitation Company", and Establish New Billing Basis

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 10.04.150 of the Bloomington Municipal
Code shall be amended to read as follows:

10.04.150 Rates - Monthly Basis. Charges for service to resi-
dential customers shall be based upon actual water usage for all
months except June, July, August and September. For these months
(when increased water consumption results from irrigation uses not
returned into sewer lines), charges shall be based upon the average
of April and May or actual usage, whichever is less. All other
customers shall be charged on the basis of 100 per cent of metered
water consumption subject to customer proof of lower wastewater use.


SECTION II. These rates shall go into effect as of March 1, 1978.
In the event the enactment of this ordinance entitled a user to a refund
or other monetary relief, the Sewer Utility shall make such adjustment
in its future billings.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the
Mayor.

SYNOPSIS

This ordinance would reinstate the old billing system for waste-
water usage of charging residential utility customers for actual usage
of water in all but the summer months, when either actual usage or the
average usage of April plus May, whichever is lower, would be used.
The rationale behind the billing basis is to not charge for sewage
use in months when water is used for watering of lawns and gardens,
and is therefore not returned to the city sewage system.
