

ORDINANCE 78-65

To Amend Chapter 2.16 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, Entitled, "Police Collective Bargaining"

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 2.16 of the Bloomington Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

2.16.060 Representatives. The City and Fraternal Order of Police shall be free to select their own spokespersons and representatives for purposes of carrying out this Chapter and shall be free of interference by the other party in that respect. Spokespersons and representatives of the City shall include the Mayor or his designees, the Director of Personnel, and such other persons as the Mayor designates and the Common Council approves prior to the beginning of negotiations. In the event the Common Council does not designate a spokesperson or representative, the Council may designate a person to attend and observe all bargaining sessions.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.


