

ORDINANCE 78- 70

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE GENERAL AND FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUNDS OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.
