SYNOPSIS

Ordinance 78-73

This budget transfer allows the City to pay outstanding or anticipated bills without resorting to special appropriations.

The City Engineer has detailed the reasons for his transfer in the accompanying memo. The Board of Safety transfer moves salaries money, unused because one member of the Board may not draw a salary, to Services Contractual where it will be used to pay long outstanding deposition bills.

The Human Rights Commission wants to transfer a portion of the unused Human Rights Attorney salary to Services Contractual in order to hire an attorney to act on appeal which must proceed before they hire a new Human Rights Attorney.
