ORDINANCE 78-75

To Repeal Section 2.02.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code  
Entitled, Appointments-Residential  
Requirement for City Boards and Commissions

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Section 2.02.040 of the Bloomington Municipal Code, entitled, "Appointments-Residential Requirement" is hereby repealed.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
