

ORDINANCE 78-93

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN THE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING TRUST, GENERAL, MOTOR VEHICLE HIGHWAY, AND PARKS AND RECREATION FUNDS OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA.



SYNOPSIS

This ordinance will transfer funds within several City departments to meet unanticipated needs. Transfers are requested from Federal Revenue Sharing - Parks and Recreation for the Dyer School Project; Human Resources Department for their new offices in the County Building; from the Mayor's Office for work study; from the Motor Vehicle Highway Fund for motor equipment and stop light repairs; from the Parks and Recreation Fund for completion of the Winslow Sports Complex and from Planning for a new chair and resources for the Transportation Study; and from the Human Rights Commission for office supplies, equipment, travel and telephone expenses.
