

ORDINANCE 78-94

To Establish a New Water Rate Structure

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Ordinance 77-88 is hereby repealed and there is hereby established for the use of and service rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Bloomington, the following rates and charges as approved by the Public Service Commission of Indiana on November 3, 1978:





#### SYNOPSIS

The Utilities Service Board and the Common Council adopted a water rate structure in October, 1977, but the Indiana Public Service Commission set a new rate structure in November, 1978. The Utility Service Board has approved the revised rate structure and it becomes effective as soon as the Public Service Commission receives it, but the Council must still formally adopt the revised rates.
