SYNOPSIS

RESOLUTION 78-19

This is the second annual membership resolution as now required by State Law.

The City Council must pass a resolution listing all organizations to which the City and its agencies will pay dues during the next year in conjunction with the passage of the City budget.

These organizations must "have as their purpose the betterment and improvement of municipal . . .government operations." (IC 18-5-7-1)
