

RESOLUTION 78-23

To Approve the Application by the Bloomington Housing  
Authority for a Preliminary Plan for Low-Rent Public Housing

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Bloomington to eliminate sub-standard and other inadequate housing, to prevent the spread of slums and blight, and to realize as soon as feasible the goal of a decent home in a suitable living environment for all of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937, as amended, the United States of America, acting through the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the "Government"), is authorized to provide financial assistance to local public housing agencies for undertaking and carrying out preliminary planning of low-rent housing projects that will assist in meeting this goal; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that there shall be local determination of need for low-rent housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enterprise and that the Government shall not make any contract with a public housing agency for preliminary loans for surveys and planning in respect to any low-rent housing projects unless the governing body of the locality involved has by resolution approved the application of the public housing agency for such preliminary loan; and


WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Bloomington, Indiana is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a preliminary loan to cover the costs of surveys and planning in connection with the development of low-rent housing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:


SECTION I. There exists in the City of Bloomington a need for low-rent housing which is not being met by private enterprise.

SECTION II. The application of the Bloomington Housing Authority to the Government for a preliminary loan in conjunction with Projects Indiana 22-4 and 22-6 in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for surveys and planning in connection with low-rent housing projects of not more than approximately 170 dwelling units is hereby approved.
