Recovering Alcoholics to the South Central Mental Health Foundation, Inc.


WHEREAS, the South Central Mental Health Foundation, Inc. has assumed responsibility for administering and coordinating the Residential Center for Recovering Alcoholics and the Detoxification Facility; and


WHEREAS, the Residential Center for Recovering Alcoholics and the Detoxification Facility will begin formal operations upon acceptance of this transfer of responsibility;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

The City of Bloomington transfers all of its responsibility for operation of the Residential Center for Recovering Alcoholics to the South Central Mental Health Foundation, Inc. effective January 1, 1979. The City will continue to administer the current Law Enforcement Assistance Administration grant supporting the Center for the duration of the grant.
