WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriated more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; now, therefore;





Synopsis

Appropriation Ordinance 78- 6

The City of Bloomington and Monroe County have reached an agreement whereby the City Animal Control Shelter will care for and dispose of animals collected in the County and deposited at the City Shelter. The County will pay the City a total of \$28,635 during 1978 for this service.

\$15,000 of that amount has already been paid to the City and must be appropriated to the existing Animal Shelter budget to permit accomodation of the extra animals.

The Human Resources department would like to appropriate revenues received from the sale of the IRIS Manual in order to pay for additional printing of the Manual.
