ORDINANCE NO. 77-28

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION
OF ADJACENT AND CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY

WHEREAS, the Boundary of the City of Bloomington, Indiana,
is adjacent to the real estate described herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA:


SECTION 1. That the following described land be, and the
same is, hereby annexed to and declared a part of the City of
Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, to-wit:

A part of Seminary Lot 58, in the Southeast Quarter
of Section 5, Township 8 North, Range 1 West, Monroe
County, Indiana, described as follows: Beginning at
a point that is 150.00 feet East of the Southwest
corner of the said Seminary Lot 58; thence North
03 degrees 02 minutes West for 417.50 feet; thence
West for 150.00 feet and to the West line of the
said Seminary Lot 58; thence North 03 degrees 02
minutes West along the said West line of Seminary
Lot 58 for 242.50 feet; thence East for 109.38
feet and to the West right-of-way of the Illinois
Central Railroad; thence South 41 degrees 15 minutes
East along the railroad right-of-way for 427.34
feet; thence South for 338.00 feet and to the South
line of the said Seminary Lot 58; thence West over
the said South line of Seminary Lot 58 for 206.45
feet and to the point of beginning, containing in
all 3.15 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, that the boundaries of
the City of Bloomington shall be, and the same are, hereby declared
to be extended so as to include all of the real estate hereinabove
described as a part of the City of Bloomington, Indiana.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect
from and after its passage, promulgation, approval by the Mayor
and publication in accordance with the law.


