

ORDINANCE 77-76

To Amend Section 1 of Ordinance 66-20, Entitled,
"An Ordinance Establishing Rates and Charges for the Use of and
Services Rendered by the Waterworks System of the City of Bloomington,
and Repealing All Ordinances or Parts of Ordinances in Conflict Therewith."

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. That Section 1 of Ordinance 66-20, adopted on April 27, 1966, is hereby amended to read as follows:

That there shall be and there are hereby established for the use of and service rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Bloomington, the following rules and charges:

Next 280,000 gallons	.75
Next 1,700,000 gallons	.65
Over 2,000,000 gallons	.60



If any section, sentence or provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any of the other sections, sentences, provisions, or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this chapter are declared to be severable.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.





Synopsis
Ordinance 77-76

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE 66-20, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH."

Indiana law requires municipal councils to enact ordinances setting the rates and charges of the municipally owned water utility. The present Ordinance, if approved, would establish new charges for: monthly usage; minimum monthly charges; surcharges for fire protection in unannexed areas served by the utility; contract sales for resale to other water companies, both public and private; municipal hydrant charges; and, private fire connections. The rates set herein are subject to review by the Indiana Public Service Commission.
