To Amend Chapter 2.64 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Concerning City Employee Residency Requirements

SYNOPSIS

Ordinance 77-85

To Amend Chapter 2.64 of the Bloomington Municipal Code Concerning City Employee Residency Requirements

Last year the Common Council passed an ordinance requiring all new City employees to live within the Bloomington City limits. The ordinance also created a Residency Review Board which was empowered to grant exemptions from the residency requirements in cases of extreme hardship. This Board has formally requested the Common Council to repeal the Residency Ordinance because they feel it is contrary to the concept of City-County cooperation, it treats employees differently based on whether they were hired before or after the ordinance was adopted, it may expose the City to legal liability because the Board has been unable to establish clear guidelines for determining "extreme hardship", and because repeal of the ordinance will make the City a more competitive employer. This ordinance would repeal the Residency Ordinance.
