SYNOPSIS

ORDINANCE 77-87

TO AMEND ORDINANCE 77-55 TO ALLOW A SALARY INCREASE FOR FIRE OFFICERS

This ordinance would amend Ordinance 77-55, the Salary Ordinance for Police and Fire Officers and Employees, to grant a salary increase of \$137.00 to those firemen who are employed for a fifty-six hour week. This figure represents the difference between forty and fiftysix hours per week times a fifteen-cent per hour increase, minus the \$300 per year increase already granted to firemen. The Common Council had tentatively approved this salary increase in Resolution 77-23.
