To Establish a New Water Rate Structure

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I. Ordinance 77-76 is hereby repealed and there is hereby established for the use of and service rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Bloomington, the following rates and charges:

SYNOPSIS

Ordinance 77-88

To Establish a New Water Rate Structure

Indiana law requires municipal councils to enact ordinances setting the rates and charges of the municipally-owned water utility. This ordinance establishes new monthly usage charges, a monthly service charge, surcharges for fire protection in unannexed areas served by the utility, contract sales for resale to other water companies, municipal hydrant charges, and private fire connections. The new charges had been approved by the Common Council in Ordinance 77-76, but because of some possible legal complications, it was agreed that the Council should send the ordinance back to the USB for their approval. The Board voted six to one to adopt the new rates, and has returned the ordinance in the form of Ordinance 77-88 which repeals and re-enacts Ordinance 77-76.
