WHEREAS, temperatures in Bloomington have fallen lower for longer than any winter in recent history, and


WHEREAS, as a result of the cold, City water pipes have frozen, affecting hundreds of Bloomington homes, causing great inconvenience for the residents thereof, and


These employees are to be highly commended for performing vital services for the residents and businesses of the City of Bloomington during this cold, cold winter of 1977.
