





TO AUTHORIZE THE CONTROLLER TO PAY DUES FOR VARIOUS ASSOCIATIONS

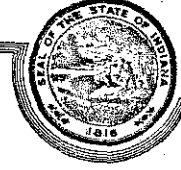
This resolution has been prepared in response to a change in State

law. The City now may pay dues only to those organizations specifically designated by the Council.

These organizations still must "have as their purpose the betterment and improvement of municipal . . . government operations." However, memberships may now be purchased in the name of an official rather than the City per se.

SUBJECT: MEMBERSHIP DUES IN ASSOCIATIONS

Attached is a copy of House Enrolled Act No. 1632, enacted as Public Law 209, Acts of the 1977 General Assembly, which will become effective when the 1977 acts are promulgated. This law amends IC 18-5-7-1, concerning membership dues in associations which have as their purpose the betterment and improvement of municipal or school governmental operations.

The 1977 law made three important changes in the former provisions of IC 18-5-7-1, as follows:

- (1) Extends authority of the common councils of cities, or boards of trustees of towns, to appropriate funds for membership dues of "the elected and appointed officials and members of their respective boards and councils." Formerly the law permitted memberships taken only in the name of the city or town.
- (2) Extends authority for memberships in "local" and "regional" associations in addition to state and national associations.
- (3) Requires the common councils of cities, or boards of trustees of towns, to designate the associations to which dues may be paid.

To assist in implementing the provisions of the 1977 law and to permit city or town officials to include the membership dues and necessary expenses incurred in attending meetings of associations in their respective budgets for the year 1978, we are enclosing a suggested form to be used by city or town officials in submitting their requests to the common councils of cities, or boards of trustees of towns. The requests should be filed with the city clerk or city clerk-treasurer as secretary to the common council, or clerk-treasurer of the town, and the clerk or clerk-treasurer should submit such requests to the council or town board not later than the August meeting, when the budget for 1978 is adopted. A supply of the form should be reproduced to meet your needs.

This procedure will then enable the common council of each city and the board of trustees of each town, to adopt an ordinance or resolution designating the associations to which dues may be paid from city or town funds and, unless otherwise directed by the council or board of trustees, will authorize each city or town official, board or council to include such dues in their budgets each year, subject to subsequent action by the city council

or town board of trustees in adding or deleting associations to which dues may be paid. It would not seem necessary to adopt an ordinance or resolution each year, unless so directed by the city council or town board of trustees.

The dues should be included in item "55 - Subscriptions and Dues" and traveling expenses in attending meetings of the associations should be included in item "213 - Traveling Expenses" in the budget of each office or department.

It should be noted that IC 18-5-7-1 does not permit payment of dues for and on behalf of deputies and employees of the cities or towns, nor are dues permitted to be paid for memberships in professional associations not meeting the provisions of this law, such as accounting societies, engineering societies, bar associations and similar professional organizations.

HOUSE ENROLLED ACT NO. 1632
(Public Law 209, Acts 1977)

AN ACT to amend IC 18-5-7 concerning appropriations by certain governmental units for organizational memberships.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 18-5-7-1 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. The common councils of cities, county councils of counties, boards of trustees of towns, and governing bodies of school corporations are hereby authorized ~~to may~~ appropriate necessary funds to provide membership of cities, counties, towns and school corporations respectively, and the elected and appointed officials and members of their respective boards and councils, in local, regional, state and national associations of a civic, educational or governmental nature which have as their purpose the betterment and improvement of municipal or school governmental operations. The governing body of the county, city, town, or school corporation shall designate the associations to which dues may be paid. Cities, counties, towns and school corporations ~~are also authorized to may~~ participate through duly designated representatives in the meetings and activities of such associations, and the common councils, county councils, boards of trustees, and governing bodies of school corporations, respectively, ~~are authorized to may~~ appropriate necessary funds to defray the expenses of such representatives in connection therewith.


