An Ordinance to Appropriate Funds from the General Fund


WHEREAS, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT IT IS NOW NECESSARY TO APPROPRIATE MORE MONEY THAN WAS APPROPRIATED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET: NOW, THEREFORE,

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON OF MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT FOR THE EXPENSES OF SAID MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY ARE HEREBY APPROPRIATED AND ORDERED SET APART OUT OF THE SEVERAL FUNDS HEREIN NAMED AND FOR THE PURPOSES HEREIN SPECIFIED, SUBJECT TO THE LAWS GOVERNING THE SAME:


SECTION II. THIS ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.





SYNOPSIS

Appropriation Ordinance 77- 1

An Ordinance to Appropriate Funds from the General Fund

This ordinance does not in fact appropriate new monies not before budgeted. It is simply the first step in the procedure to transfer monies from one department's budget into another.

Through this procedure, the City will move salary monies from Planning and Engineering to the Court budget. This will result in the Judge being paid entirely from the General Fund while one position in Planning and one in Engineering will be paid in part by Utilities and part by General Fund.

This is being done to satisfy ethical objections to paying the Judge from Utilities monies.
